System Requirements

Linux/Windows
PHP 5.3 or greater
MySQL database server 4.1 or greater
Apache or IIS5/6 Web Server

Other settings

SendMail - (Yes)
PHP safe mode - (OFF)
PHP open_basedir - (OFF)
CURL extension - (Yes)
GD complied with your PHP Build - (Yes)
DOMXML extension - (Yes)

Install Checklist

1. Create a new MySQL database with new user that has full rights to it.
2. Upload iScripts EasyCreate files.
3. Run install script.
4. Delete install directory.
5. Customize as desired.
6. Test.
7. Go Live!

Installation

Create Database

Create a new MySQL database and new user with full rights to the database. Check with your server's control panel documentation for details on how to create databases on your system.

Upload files

Unzip the iScripts Easycreate full install zip file with paths in your computer. Upload all files maintaining the directory structure. Upload in binary mode.

OR

Upload the iScripts Easycreate full install zip file and unzip on your server. If you do this, be sure your files are owned by the user who owns the site.

Run the install script

Open a new browser window. Surf to [http://\[your_ iScripts EasyCreate_domain\]/install/install.php](http://[your_ iScripts EasyCreate_domain]/install/install.php) (Substitute your domain name for [your_ iScripts EasyCreate_domain])

Step 1:

The first screen contains 4 sections :

1. File Permissions section
2. Database Details section
3. Site Details section
4. Administration Details section

File Permission section

This section gives option to provide file permissions. You have two ways to give the file permissions.

- a. Can manually give permissions for the listed files. In this case, no need to provide FTP Username and FTP Password.
- b. System will automatically give permissions for the specified files. But should provide FTP Username and FTP Password.

Database Details section

This section displays the following fields to fill

- a. Database Server Hostname – enter the hostname of your database server.
- b. Database Name – name of your database.
- c. Database User Name – database username.
- d. Database Password – database password.
- e. Database Prefix – specify a name as table prefix.

Site Details section

Site Name - Enter the name of the site

LicenseKey – Enter the Licensekey

Administration Details section

Admin Email – Email address of the administrator

Step 2:

If the installation is successful you will get the following message

“Congratulations! The Installation Process is completed successfully! ”

iScripts Easycreate installation is complete!

Remove or rename and relocate the install directory. This is a security measure, you don't want anyone surfing to it.
